HOSTING DISTRICT: District 4500 - Rotary Club de Natal Reis Magos

WHERE: Natal, Northeastern Brazil

THEME: "From Mountain to Sea"- sport, swimming, trail, social project.

District 4500 is located in the Northeast of Brazil and encompasses the states of Pernambuco, Paraíba and Rio Grande do Norte. This region is extremely endowed with natural beauties, such as the magnificent scattered beaches, which are an invitation to take a dip in the clear, warm waters. Besides, we have the charm of the mountains that lure the adventurous traveler.

During the Camp "From Mountain to Sea", students will have the opportunity to visit outstanding sites in our district and to live with Brazilian families for some days in a **SHORT TERM FAMILY TO FAMILY PROGRAM**.

They will also have the opportunity to get to know a social project that offers free surfing lessons to underprivileged children..

CAMP PERIOD: Friday August 11th 2023 - Sunday August 22th 2023

ARRIVAL- DEPARTURE: The FAMILY TO FAMILY can get started, either in the month of July or August. Families can set arrival and departure dates in Natal for the

Short Term Program, keeping in mind that students taking part in the Camp must arrive in Natal before August 10th and leave Natal after August 22th.

AIRPORT - Aeroporto Internacional de Natal (NAT) - Governador Aluízio Alves

PARTICIPANTS - Total 12 girls and boys from different countries interested in nature and adventure.

AGE - 15 to 19 years old.

15 August - Visit in a Social Project that teaches surfing to children in the community
16 August - Barra de Tabatinga Beach, Pirangi Beach (Giant Cashew Tree)
17 August - Barra do Cunhaú Beach
18 August - Jenipabu Beach (buggy's ride)
19 August - Pipa Beach
20 August - Sagi Beach
21 August - Galinhos Beach
22 August - August - Perobas Beach

The order of the tours can be changed, according to weather and logistical conditions in the period.

In case any of the tours is canceled, another one of the same quality will be offered.

Detailed program will be sent to participants.

REQUIREMENT - Participants should be able to swim and should be in good physical condition.

Special Remark - Parents are requested to certify that the participant is in good health and allowed to take part in all scheduled activities; they agree to medical care if necessary.

LANGUAGE - English - participants must have a working knowledge in English.

ACCOMODATION - Host families and hotel accompanied by rotarians.

DRESSCODE - casual & sportive outdoor clothes

CAMP FEE - 600 Euros to be paid upon arrival in Natal

-Participants pay their own costs to and from Natal and must have their own pocket money.

INSURANCE - Every participant must be insured, covering illness, accident and third-party damages, according to Rotary International recommendations for STEP Programs.
