CAMP DETAILS

Camp Language: English

Registration Fee: 500 Euro (After Acceptance)

Attendants' other financial responsibilities

Arrival Airport to Turkey: Ankara Esenboğa Airport (ESB)

Departure Airport After Camp: Sinop Airport

Students must bring money for personal expenses and extras.

Journey and Travel Insurance is mandatory

Clothing: It is recommended to wear comfortable shoes as there will be excursions during the tour. Since there is a boat trip and sea during the tour, swimsuits, hats, slippers etc. Equipment must be brought. Additionally, sun protection cream should be available.

Health: During the application, the student's allergy sensitivities, if any, should be shared. Food etc. that they may be exposed to an allergic reaction to. conditions must be communicated.

NOT ALLOWED: Alcohol consumption, smoking and various drugs, etc.

Possession is prohibited.

The number of people attending the camp is expected to be at least 5. If fewer than 5 applications are received, camp cancellation is at the discretion of the organizing clubs.

CAMP ROUTE:

On July 27, students will be picked up from Ankara Esenboğa Airport between 08:00-17:00 by city bus or Roterian vehicles. An intercity bus transfer will be provided to Kastamonu on August 1 and from Kastamonu to Sinop on August 5. On August 10, between 08:00 and 17:00, students will be boarded and sent to the plane from Sinop Airport.

CAMPING TRIP PLAN:

A cultural program was prepared in Ankara along the tour route. Anıtkabir, where the grave of Turkey's founder Mustafa Kemal Atatürk is located, will be visited. The 1st and 2nd Parliament, where the foundations of Turkey were laid, Ankara Castle, Ethnography Museum, Koç Museum, Anatolian Civilizations Museum will be visited. A 1-day trip will be made to Ankara's Beypazarı district.

An integrated cultural and nature program has been prepared in the Kastamonu travel plan. There will be trips to the City Museum, Taşköprü Pompeipolis, Hat - Ethnography and Horma Daday. There will be a trip to Küre Mountains, the first national park in Turkey to receive the PAN Parks certificate, which is Europe's network of exclusive protected areas. There will also be a one-day trip to ILGAZ in Kastamonu.

Sinop travel program will be a trip that includes sea, sand and sun. In the Sinop program, there will be trips and walks in special areas such as the Archaeological Museum, Süleyman Pervane Madrasa, Sinop Castle, Ethnography Museum Sightseeing and Erfelek Waterfall. Summer will be enjoyed at Bektaşağa Lake, Boat Tour, İnceburun and Karakum Beach/Aquapark.
