All participants should be a good swimmer and be in good physical condition.

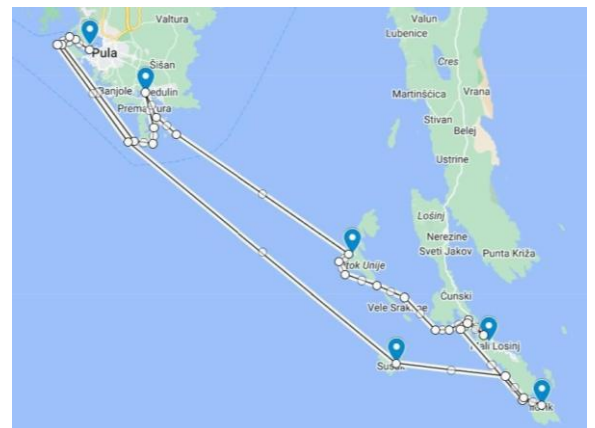
Meeting Point for Departure
