WELCOME to our Summer Camp in South Hungary, along the river Danube (next to the unique Gemenc forest) – in Baja

Program Outline: Discover and enjoy Baja city and its surrounding with the unique Gemenc forest, part of the Danube-Drava National Park (the greatest continuous floodplain forest of Europe)

We offer you:

- to know and enjoy our city of Mediterranean atmosphere
- to see the culture, life, habits, music, dance of the different nationalities living together here in peace (Hungarians, Germans, Croats, Serbs...)
- and to enjoy the attractive nature/environment of our town

Join us:

- right after your arrival to see and discover our wonderful capital, Budapest; admire its amazing historical buildings and sights during a day-trip, and enjoy its special beauty also by night
- to have bicycle tours in our city and the unique Gemenc forest region
- to get to know the flora and fauna of the forest (deer, wild boars, special birds)
- to take motorboats to a peaceful sand island of the Danube for having an unforgettable day
- to enjoy countless programs during your Hungarian holiday (e.g.: fishing; cooking and tasting the famous fish soup of Baja with noodles; watersport activities of the river Sugovica; birds watching and ringing; beekeeping)
- to see in work and taste of products of historical windmill and ship-mill
- to know the famous Lipicai-horses and Grey cattle
- to participate in many other exciting things

Purpose of the camp: Introduce the natural beauty and traditions of the Baja region to foreign students, especially in the light of the connection to the aquatic life.

Age group: Boys and girls aged 14-17

Communication language: English

Conditions for application: Safe, certified swimming knowledge, rules of bicycle use and practical knowledge.

Date of the camp: 21.06.2026. Sunday – 04.07.2026. Saturday, i.e. 14 days/13 nights

Arrival: Sunday, June 21, before 5 p.m.

Liszt Ferenc Airport (BUD), or Bus Station and Railway Station in Budapest Participants will be welcomed by Rotarians.

Departure: Saturday, July 04. after 10 a.m. from Budapest

Number of participants: Up to 16 persons

Accommodation: 2-3 bed hotel rooms in Budapest and 2-4 bed apartman rooms in Baja, half board (no nights with families)

Provision: Full board (3 meals a day)

Camp fee: 450 euros plus the cost of arrival in and departure from Budapest to home, spending money recommended, travel insurance

Insurance:	The participant must be insured against illness, accident and third party damages according to Rotary International recommendations
Transport of campers:	by Bus
Supervision:	24 hours a day, English-speaking teacher
Programme Guide:	online in English for every participant

Detailed Program of camp Baja (Nature and Adventure)

Day 1 – Sunday (21 June)

Arrival in Budapest, hotel reservation, evening sightseeing.

City tour on foot with a guide in Buda Castle and Heroes' Square, then departure to Csopak (Lake Balaton), accommodation; occupation, free program.

Day 3 – Tuesday (23 June)

Visit to Tihany and Salföld.

Day 4 – Wednesday (24 June)

Reef tour, a joint program with Baja club members on the Baja coast of the Danube, trips with motorboats, bathing, eating on the reef.

Day 5 – Thursday (25 June)

Visiting a working windmill in a village, close to Baja. There is a horse show and than horse-drawn carriage riding. Evening visit to the Rotary Club in Baja and bowling together.

Day 6 – Friday (26 June)

Fishing in a fish lake, then visiting a ranch with the Hungariana gray-cattle herd and there common cooking of local foods. In the afternoon traditional Hungarian archery demonstration, swimming, sunbathing and water sport activities in a small lake at the ranch.

Visit an an Ecotourism Center at Pörböly, wild observation, beekeeping Collection.
